POLYESTER CARPETS

POLYESTER

Polyester yarns are synthetic yarns produced from petroleum. These yarns are soft, hypoallergenic, have good stability, high light fastness and are very easy to maintain. In case of spills or stains, you can easily clean a polyester carpet with water and mild soap.

An important property of this fiber is that it retains color very well. This offers the possibility of colorful carpets. It is a very durable fiber, which on top of that hardly wrinkles or shrinks.

We use polyester yarns partly in our warp threads (both spun and filament yarns) for strength during weaving and partly for pile purposes. In pile yarns, we use filament yarns that do not show pilling.

MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS

VACUUM

It is recommended to vacuum the carpet immediately after installation. Keep your carpet clean and in good condition by vacuuming it every week. This will also prevent dirt from penetrating deep into the fibers. Definitely do not use a rotary brush as this will damage the carpet. It is recommended to use an average vacuum cleaner, possibly with beater function.

WHAT TO DO IN CASE OF STAINS?

Remove as much of the stain as possible with a clean cloth. Solid pieces of dirt can be removed with a spoon.

Then use water and mild soap to further clean the carpet. Rub lightly or dab with the liquid, starting from the outer edge of the dirt and working inward. Repeat until the stain is gone.

When you're done, be sure not to forget to remove all soap residue with water. Afterwards, let the wet spot dry before putting the carpet back (to avoid mold).

If the stain remains stubborn, it is best to call in a professional carpet cleaner.
